Dear Dr. Schmidt:

This is to notify you that your registration renewal application to import nonhuman primates has been approved. Your registration is effective through December 27, 2024. Animals imported must be for scientific, educational, and exhibition purposes and for resale or other distribution only for such purposes in accordance with Title 42, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 71, Subpart F, Section 71.53 (<https://www.govinfo.gov/content/pkg/FR-2013-02-15/pdf/2013-03064.pdf>). Registration may be renewed by submitting an application packet to [nhpimporters@cdc.gov](mailto:nhpimporters@cdc.gov) 30-60 days before the expiration date.

Registered importers are required to make arrangements for compliance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) regulation noted above prior to authorizing the shipment of any nonhuman primate into the United States. Importers must notify this office when an importation is planned and provide details of the shipment and the final itinerary at least 7 days prior to the actual importation. We will work with you to facilitate proper handling and prompt clearance at the port of entry.

Instructions are enclosed for reporting and record keeping as required of registered importers. If you have any questions about reporting and record keeping or other aspects of the Public Health Service regulations restricting importation of nonhuman primates, please let us know.
